ESTIMATED EXPENSES FOR ALABAMA LANGUAGE INSTITUTE (1 SEMESTER = 16 WEEKS)

1. Tuition (15 credit hours @ \$189 per hour)*	\$ 2,835.00
2. Books and supplies**	\$ 250.00
3. Medical Insurance (5 months)***	\$ 196.00
4. Room and board (1 student per room)****	\$ 1,600.00
One time dorm deposit of \$200.00 not included	
TOTALS	\$ 4,881.00

**Estimated cost for 2 semesters \$9,762.00 (summer not included).
Personal spending varies, but \$225.00 per month is average. (See note below.)**

Explanation of the expenses for each item listed above:

- *1. Core curriculum program: 18 hours per week -15 hours of language classes and 3 hours of Directed Laboratory (free of charge). (Cost per one (1) credit hour is \$189.00)
Half sessions are available at the beginning of semesters.
 - **2. This is an estimated amount.
 - ***3. (a) Insurance coverage is required during the entire year.
(b) Cost of medical insurance per year is \$588.00. Fall Semester is \$196.00 (5 months) and Spring & Summer is \$392.00 (7 months)
(c) The medical insurance does not cover pre-existing conditions.
(d) In addition, eyeglasses/dental services are not covered by medical insurance.
 - ****4. (a) A one-time refundable deposit of \$200.00 is required if staying in the Residence Hall
(c) Cafeteria is open for breakfast, lunch, and dinner from Monday through Friday.
(b) Cafeteria is closed weekends and holidays. Transportation is provided on these days.
(d) Summer Semester (10 weeks) room and board fees are \$1000.00.
- Note:** (a) **Additional expenses include** expenses between semesters and on holidays, weekend meals, clothes, laundry, and personal needs.
(b) If the student lives off-campus and /or purchases a car, additional expenses will exceed the average.

Important information: Room and board must be paid on arrival. Tuition and medical insurance must be paid at the time of registration. These expenses can be paid by money order, cash, credit card (Visa or Master Card), traveler's check, or by a cashier's check from a U.S. bank or institution.
