We will explore the process of hand building and wheel throwing. The emphasis will be on surface texture and the many different ways to achieve texture on the surface of the pot before considering underglazes and glazes. Primarily, our focus will be on tableware, which includes basic shapes: the cup, tumbler, mug and the pitcher. We will be decorating our tableware using tinted slips and underglazes.

Price: \$150 per student, which includes student materials, firing fees, tools for the duration of the class, one day per week for 2 months: 8 classes total. This class will continue to rotate throughout the year, every 8 weeks, to offer others who might have an interest in pursuing ceramics.
