## ELIGIBILITY

---

**Veterans Upward Bound (VUB) is a TRiO program funded 100% by a grant from the U.S. Department of Education.**

- A veteran who has served more than 180 active duty days as a member of the Armed Forces of the United States and who was discharged or released from active duty under conditions other than dishonorable; **or** a veteran discharged or released from active duty due to a service-connected disability; and
  - who is low-income, according to federal guidelines, **and/or** neither parent (natural or adoptive) earned a degree from a four-year college or university; and
  - who possesses a desire, need, and commitment to enter and complete a postsecondary education or training program.
