Nursing Program Requirements

- Unconditional admission to the college
- A completed application for admission to nursing program received before the published deadline
- A minimal of 18 ACT composite score National or Residual
- A minimum of 2.5 GPA for nursing required academic core courses and minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA at current, native institution or cumulative 2.0 in institution from which student is transferring
- Meeting the essential functions for nursing
- **Generic Students** (Students without health care License) ***Must*** have successfully completed with a grade of “C” or better in MTH 100
- **Mobility Students** are additionally required to provide proof of unencumbered, Alabama licensure (LPN, Paramedic). No work history is required. No associate degree is required for paramedics. Completed prerequisites with a grade of “C” or better required for mobility program application: [ENG 101](#), [MTH 100](#), or higher-level math, [BIO 201 & 202](#), [SPH 106 or 107](#), and [PSY 210](#).

Nursing Program Selection Criteria

- ACT Score = 36 possible points. No time limit on when the ACT was taken.
- Points for grades in the following nursing required core general educational courses ([ENG 101](#), [MTH 100](#) or higher, [BIO 201](#) and [202](#))
 - A = 3 points
 - B = 2 points
 - C = 1 points
 - D = 0 point
 - Additional Points: 10pts = First admission to a Registered nursing program or for mobility students 10 points if this is your first admission to a mobility program.
- Applicants will be ranked from highest to lowest total score until the predetermined number of students is selected.

Suggested Schedule before entering program:

1st semester	MTH 100 ENG 101 BIO 201
2nd semester	BIO 202 PSY 210 SPH 106 or 107
3rd semester	BIO 220 Hum Elective

Take as many [pre – requisite courses](#) as [possible](#) before entering program.

Once you are selected into the nursing program, a ***mandatory orientation session*** is required.

Log in to Your Student Systems

One ACCS Self-Service Banner

- Allows students to register for classes, view current schedule, pay tuition, check financial aid status, view grades, view transcripts, access DegreeWorks, etc.
- Login credentials: username (A#) and PIN

MyGadsdenState

- Allows students to access Student Email/O365 account
- Allows students to access Blackboard (Gadsden State's Learning Management System or LMS)
 - o Pro-tip: Courses are not visible in Blackboard until the 1st day of class
- Login credentials: emailed to students the day they clear admissions (sender is FIM Service)
 - o Didn't receive the email? Click "Forgot Username" and your username and temporary password will be sent via email.
 - o Pro-tip: You will be prompted to set up security questions and change your password upon first login

A grade of less than 75% in any required nursing course constitutes failure. A student may not progress in the program until all nursing courses are successfully completed in the required sequence. A student who has failed any required nursing course for any two semesters can request readmission one time only as a new student within one year of non-progression or reinstatement.

A minimum grade of "C" (70%) is required in each general education course in the program. A student who does not attain a grade of "C" in each general education course by the semester specified in the catalog/website will be dismissed from the program until the course is repeated and the required grade earned. After the required grade is earned, the student may apply for readmission, following the procedure in the catalog/website, www.gadsdenstate.edu. Academic Bankruptcy and course forgiveness may not be applied to NUR courses.

*NOTE: Humanities disciplines include but are not limited to the following: Literature, Ethnic Studies, Foreign Language Literature, Philosophy, Ethics, and Religious Studies.
