This campus contains several academic and health science programs. It also features Fowler Residence Hall, Wallace Hall Fine Arts Center, the cafeteria, and much more.

001 Allen Hall

Common Subjects: Math, English, Speech, Humanities

Allen Hall is one of our newly-renovated buildings on campus. This building contains 22 spacious classrooms that are used to teach general education courses including math, English, speech, and other first-year courses. Here, students can lounge, work together, and take advantage of the beautiful views of the campus' central courtyard.

Allen Hall is currently Home to Meadows LRC, Student ID Services, TRIO for Success, and Cardinal Tutoring Center.

004 Wallace Hall Fine Arts Center

Common Subjects: Art, Music, Theatre

Wallace Hall Fine Arts Center is the performing and visual arts complex on the campus of Gadsden State. With 1,215 seats, it is the largest theater of its type in northeast Alabama and has hosted a variety of events. The Gadsden State Show Choir and Showband rehearse and host performances in this venue which also hosts community events from organization across the state. The division of Fine Arts is also housed in Wallace Hall offering classes in art, music, and theatre.

005 Naylor Hall

Common Subjects: Computer Science, Business, Psychology, Sociology, History

The Division of Business, Legal Studies and Computer Science includes the instructional programs in accounting, business, economics, criminal justice, marketing management, office administration and paralegal studies.

The Social Sciences Division includes the instructional programs in Child Development, Philosophy, Geography, Political Science, History, Psychology, Home Economics, Religion, Human Services and Sociology.

006 Beck Field House

Beck Field House is home to Gadsden State Athletics. Our four teams – men's and women's basketball, men's tennis, and women's volleyball—compete in the National Junior College Athletic Association. Beck Field house is also home to Beck Conference Center, Veteran's Upward Bound, and the areas of interest of pre-athletic training and health, physical education, and recreation.

007 Inzer Hall

Inzer Hall is our main student services hub on campus. Inside, students will find services to help them be successful at Gadsden State, including Meadows Library, the Cardinal Tutoring Center, and Student Support Services. Students can meet in the cafeteria downstairs or here in the breezeway to socialize and study between classes.

While the building is partially closed for Fall 2022, the Cafeteria is open.

009 Bevill Hall

Bevill Hall is home to Gadsden State's popular and in-demand health science programs of radiologic technology, medical lab technology, and phlebotomy are also here in Bevill Hall. These selective admissions programs allow students to begin careers in the ever-evolving health field and impact the lives of patients in various medical settings.

050 Fowler Hall
